Added value of the National Chapter over and above what is currently being done within the country (300 words max)*

In France, we have different institutions (evaluation and funding agencies, employers such as national research organisations and universities), which conduct evaluations of different types: National Research Organisations, Universities, evaluation and funding agencies, research units, research projects, recruitment and career promotion, bonuses, etc.

The added value of the national chapter will be to create a common knowledge by sharing each process when establishing the French state of the art in each institution.

Work plan and outputs / deliverables, that can be accomplished within the timeline proposed (600 words max)*

- *Presentation of the state of the art with a public display (State of the art in each institution plus a summary of the state of the art in France on the COARA FRANCE website)*
- *List of resources and skills available in each institution to consider training of evaluators*
- *Training of trainers*
- *Creation of a space for sharing resources (COARA France website)*
- *Translation of the COARA EU documents into French so that each institution can appropriate them.*

Mechanisms to ensure that a broader range of organisations, including from outside CoARA, contribute to and benefit from the National Chapter (300 words max)*

The basis of our group was a national working group of DORA signatories, which was initiated by the French Committee for Open Science and organised the 2022 Open Science European Conference. It has evolved into the French CoARA group, under the name CoARA-FRANCE.

The group is open to all French CoARA member organisations, with the goal of having 100% of them, with the French Ministry of Research acting as facilitator.

Final productions will be available to all institutions, including non-members.


